What data do we process?

- When booking accommodation or a massage: name, surname, contact details, and possibly billing information.

- During payments: payment information.
- When using the website: IP address, cookies, traffic statistics. What do we use the data for? • to conclude and fulfill the accommodation or massage agreement,
- to comply with legal obligations (e.g., accounting, reporting the stay of foreigners),
- for communication with customers and – if you give consent – also for sending newsletters. How do we protect your data?
- we make it accessible only to authorized persons or legally designated institutions,
- we store it only for the necessary period,
- we never sell it to third parties.

What personal data we collect and why we collect it  
Comments When visitors leave comments on the site, we collect the data shown in the comment form, as well as the IP address and browser user-agent for spam protection. An anonymized string created from your email address (also called a hash) may be provided to the Gravatar service to check if you are using it.
